Nomination Categories

Team London is the Mayor's ambitious programme to help make London a better place through the efforts of volunteers to improve community safety, increase youth opportunities, build stronger neighbourhoods and clean and green London.

The Team London Awards are our chance to celebrate not only the excellence of volunteers but the amazing things we can accomplish when we work together to make London the best city it can be.

Categories

Team London will be giving four awards in each of the following categories:

Improving Community Safety

Increasing Youth Opportunities

Building Stronger Neighbourhoods

Cleaning & Greening London

The four awards given will be:

- The volunteer who has shown the most enthusiasm and commitment within each of the above categories
- The volunteer who has given especially valued long service or contributed particular depth of experience within each of the above categories
- The group of volunteers that has achieved more towards each of the categories above by working together
- The four organisations showing the best practice in managing volunteers and/or showing committed and effective leadership in each of the above categories (Application form for these awards available separately)


In addition, our media partners Archant London 24 will present an award to the Team London Star that they feel is their top volunteering hero, and one person will be selected from all candidates for a Mayor's Award.



Criteria for individual awards

- Individual must be based in London and their effort or contribution must benefit London or Londoners
- Activities need to have contributed to improving community safety, increasing youth opportunities, building stronger neighbourhoods or cleaning & greening London
- Nominee must be a current volunteer
- Contribution should stand out from others doing similar work - exceptional either in terms of effort or the outcome which has been achieved
- Work must have been done on a voluntary/unpaid basis
- Work must have demonstrable impact
- The individual has volunteered on a regular basis, or over a period of time
- Demonstration of commitment - minimum of 100 hours/6 months of volunteering
- Longevity - minimum of 5 years volunteering
- Activity should be associated with a named project, campaign, group, charity or organisation which is registered or otherwise verifiable and/or has made or is making a considerable impact on a person, group of people, or area within London
- Self nominations will not be accepted, nominations need to be made by a third party

Criteria for Team Awards

- Members of the team must be based in London and efforts or contributions must benefit London or Londoners
 - Activities need to have contributed to improving community safety, increasing youth opportunities, building stronger neighbourhoods or cleaning & greening London
 - Activity of team must have taken place within the last year
 - Contribution should stand out from that of other teams doing similar work - exceptional either in terms of effort or the outcome which has been achieved
 - All activity must have been done on a voluntary/unpaid basis
 - Work must have demonstrable impact
 - Activity should be associated with a named project, campaign, group, charity or organisation which is registered or otherwise verifiable and/or has made or is making a considerable impact on a person, group of people, or area within London
 - Self nominations will not be accepted, nominations need to be made by a third party
