Categories

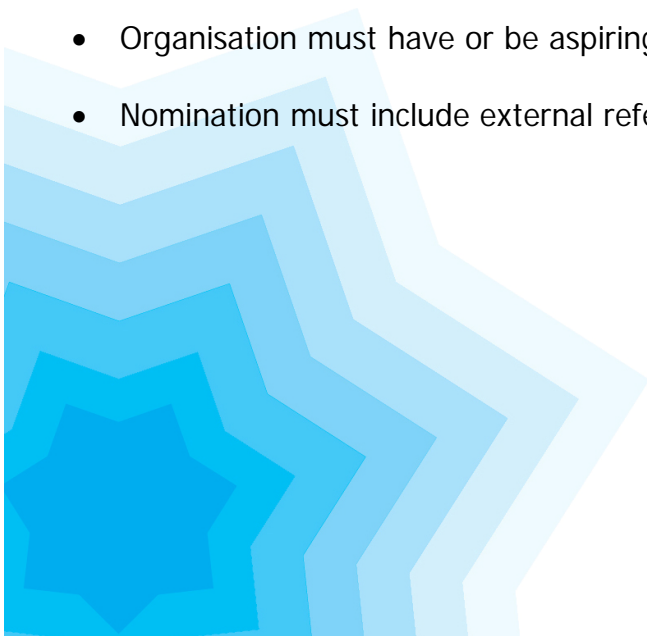
Team London will be giving awards to organisations that have shown best practice in managing volunteers and/or showing committed and effective leadership. One award will be given in each of the following categories:

Improving Community Safety
Increasing Youth Opportunities
Building Stronger Neighbourhoods
Cleaning & Greening London

Awards for individual volunteers or teams of volunteers can be applied for separately.

Criteria for Best Practice Awards

- This award will be given to organisations that show best practice in managing volunteers and/or showing committed and effective leadership
- Organisation must be based in London and efforts or contributions must benefit London or Londoners
- Activities need to have contributed to improving community safety, increasing youth opportunities, building stronger neighbourhoods or cleaning & greening London
- Contribution should stand out from that of other organisations doing similar work
- Organisation should be signed up to London's Volunteer Management Charter
- Organisation must have or be aspiring to IIV (UK accreditation in volunteering - quality mark)
- Nomination must include external references from volunteers they have managed
